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ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY

There is a direct correlation between a student's attendance, and his/her interest, achievement and attitude. For the benefit of your child and all students, it is imperative that your child arrives on time and remains in school until the end of the session. DISMISSAL

Parents are asked to drive around to the East side of the building for 12:00 carpool. Your children will be called outside to your car. Children will not be released to anyone other than a parent or regular carpool driver without permission from the parent. Please text Esther if someone other than the parent will be picking up your child. Please help us keep our students safe by following our dismissal policy.

TZEDAKAH

Tzedakah (charity) is a concept that is basic to Judaism. CHS strives to develop a commitment among our students to share with others less fortunate than themselves, by donating a few pennies each day to charity.
